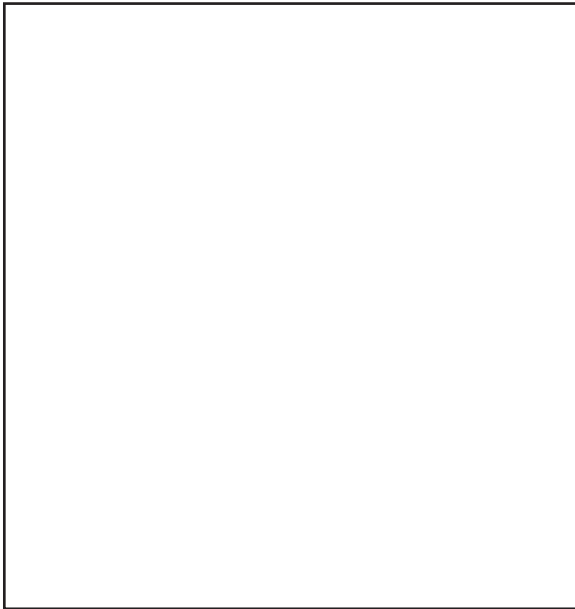


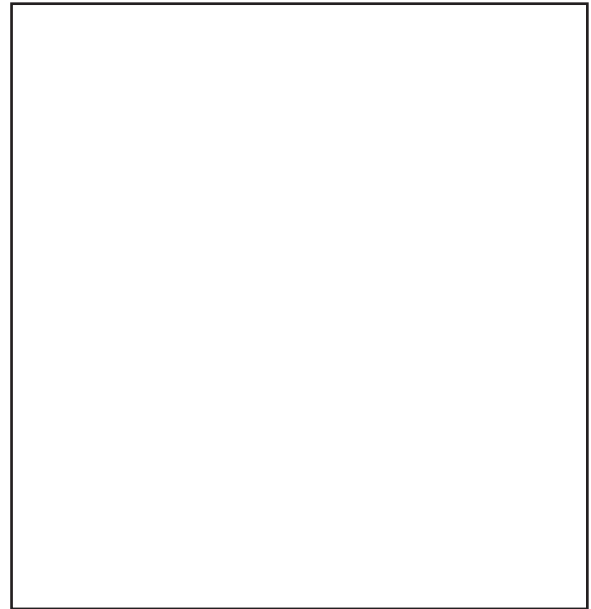
Title **Begin at the Beginning...**

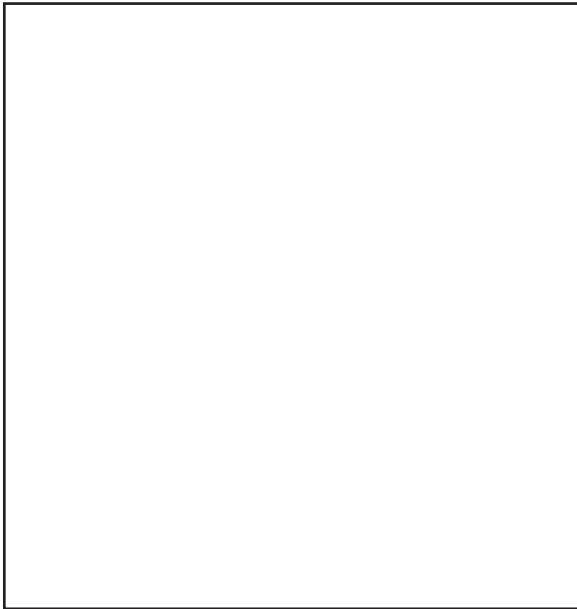
Title **A Short Ride Home**

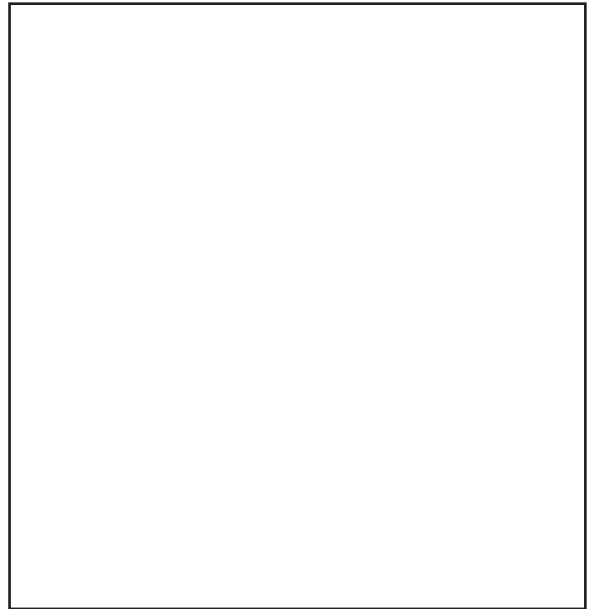

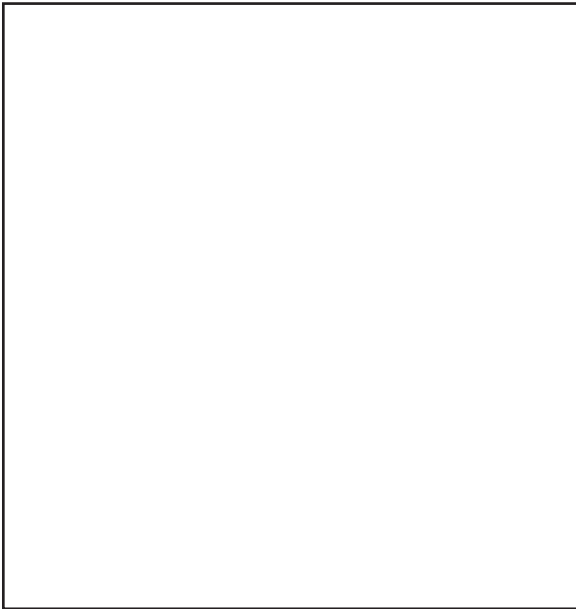

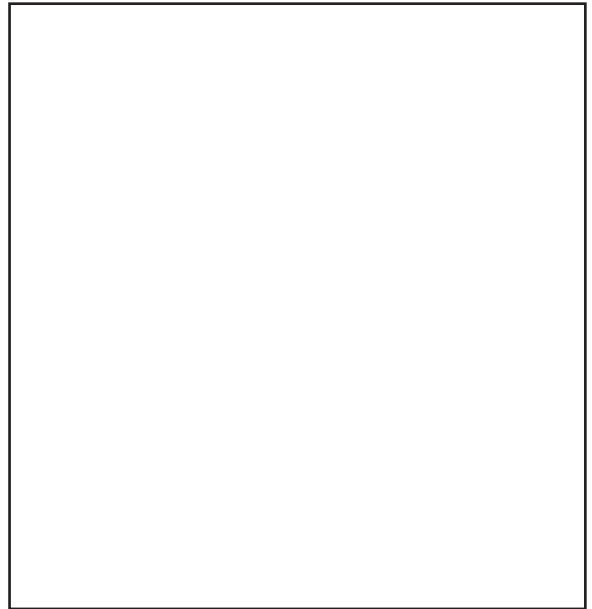
